The General Program Goals of Luverne School District #2184 are:

To emphasize instruction in math, science and communication -- reading, writing, speaking and listening -- which will enable students to be competent in future endeavors.

- e. Strengthening lines of communication between administrators/teachers and the home.

To enhance the self-esteem of students, administrators, faculty, and staff, as well as to instill a positive feeling of self-worth and value as an individual.

To advance basic social science attitudes and skills by providing opportunities for students to:

- a. Gain historical perspectives regarding our country and its relationship to the world
- b. Increase global awareness
- c. Understand and exercise responsible citizenship
- d. Realize the need for productivity within society

To assess, identify, and provide appropriate programs for all learners, regardless of ability.

To assess staff development needs and provide staff development programs and opportunities which will empower professional growth.

To promote appropriate use of leisure time -- physical, intellectual, and creative.

To promote the application of essential learning.

To work in cooperation and harmony with other institutions in the community.

To work toward the development of a cooperation and combination agreement with neighboring School Districts.
